



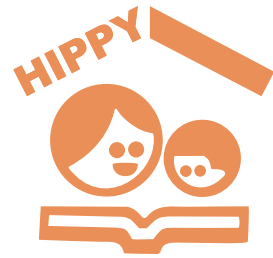
Review of mothers about HIPPY

Fit for School

What HIPPY is

- HIPPY is a learning program for children starting with 4 years.
- HIPPY supplements the offer of the kindergarten in a meaningful way.
- HIPPY empowers children for school.
- Children and parents significantly improve their German language skills.
- HIPPY shows parents how to promote the development of their children playfully at home.
- The HIPPY - activities are fun for the kids as well as for the parents. These positive experiences with each other deepens the parent-child relationship.
- For parents with an immigration history HIPPY means an important source of information about topics (such) as school, health care, nutrition and education issues.
- A personal financial contribution is mandatory.



How does HIPPY work

- HIPPY takes place at home.
- HIPPY takes two years in total and 30 weeks a year. The sequence is based on the school season.
- The parents are playing and learning with their children 20 minutes a day during the program.
- HIPPY learning material will be delivered and explained to you by a HIPPY home visitor.
- HIPPY home visitors are women with an immigrant history and particularly instructed for their task. They are bilingual and know how to explain the HIPPY parents translation aids.
- Periodically group meetings will be held for all HIPPY participants in a district. The meetings will be conducted by an expert in education issues. In these meetings we will discuss education issues and parents have opportunity to exchange personal experiences.
